Mt. Gilead is a 501c3 non-profit organization and we rely on donations from supporters like you to help keep our summer camp tuition as affordable as possible while also covering our annual operating budget: utility bills, property taxes, facility maintenance as well as our growing scholarship program.

COVID-19 Financial Loss: In 2020 and part of 2021, Mt. Gilead lost tens-of-thousands in annual income (due to canceled summer camp and retreat groups) which would annually go towards the costs listed above. Any donation made towards our December Annual Appeal will help lessen the burden on our non-profit as we enter into 2022. We have set a goal of 30K in November/December, and we are praying we will surpass that.
